**SYNOPSIS:**

This bill amends Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) to provide for automatic expungement of offenses for which a pardon is granted.

**SUMMARY:**

Amends Section 9122 of Title 18 (relating to expungement) to require that criminal history record information in a specific proceeding be expunged when the person has been pardoned for the offense.

Requires the prosecuting attorney and permits the court to maintain a list of names and criminal history record information for persons who have been pardoned for the sole purpose of determining the person's eligibility for pretrial and post-trial diversion or probation programs in the future.

**EFFECTIVE DATE:**

Effective in 60 days.
