I am writing at this time to ask for your support of Senate Bill 1215 which would transfer County Clerks of Courts, Prothonotaries and selected Deputies to the Judicial system service.

As Carbon County Clerk of Courts for the past twenty-five (25) years and former Director of the Bureau of Collections in Carbon County (1981-1985) and Lehigh County (1985-1989), I find it very important that these offices should finally come under the Unified Judicial System.

Under this proposal these offices will continue to standardize state wide court practices and collection procedures and eliminate existing disparities to establish a more cohesive efficient operation.
