SYNOPSIS:

This bill amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) to intercept state income tax refunds to pay outstanding court-ordered obligations, such as restitution, fines, and costs.

SUMMARY:

This bill requires the Department of Revenue to implement a state income tax refund intercept program when it is cost-effective to do so for any person owing court-ordered obligations as a result of a criminal conviction. This program will only apply to individual tax returns.

Effective Date: This bill is effective in sixty days.

BILL HISTORY:

There is no bill history during this legislative session.
