11 (b) Exception.--If an applicant is unable to appear in
12 person because of his active military service or because the
13 office of the register of wills is closed due to a state of
14 disaster emergency declared by the Governor under 35 Pa.C.S. §
15 7301(c) (relating to general authority of Governor) or a
16 declaration of judicial emergency under Article V of the
17 Constitution of Pennsylvania, a law of this Commonwealth, a rule
18 of court or other judicial order by the Supreme Court or any
19 agency or unit of the unified judicial system exercising a power
20 or performing a duty under 42 Pa.C.S. § 1721 (relating to
21 delegation of powers), the applicant shall be permitted to
22 forward an affidavit, which verifies all of the information
23 required under subsection (a), to the issuing authority.

24 * * *

25 Section 2. The amendment of 23 Pa.C.S. § 1306(b) shall be
26 retroactive to March 18, 2020.

27 Section 3. This act shall take effect as follows:

28 (1) The amendment of 23 Pa.C.S. § 1304(b) shall take
29 effect in 60 days.

30 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect
31 immediately.
